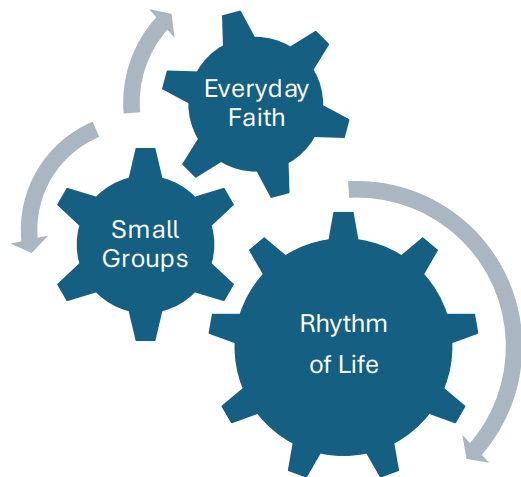


Mission Statement:

"Everyday Faith": We call this Ministry

We do this by helping people recognize God's presence in their daily routines. It encourages believers to view their work, home life, and leisure through the lens of faith. This is where we take all the stuff we have learned and put it into practice. Some of this will be in practical terms and may be covered by multiple different spheres. Other areas are re those of soft evangelism and social gospel opportunities (eg ministry to the poor, needy and aged etc, through for example the Foodbank.

Small Group: We call this Fellowship

Our various small groups (Housegroup, Mens' Group, Ladies Group) are designed to discuss daily life, share stories of where they have seen God, and encourage one another in Christian growth and understanding, and accountability.

Rhythm of Life: We call this worship.

This is where we take all the stuff we have learned and put it into practice. We encourage throughout the church a "Rhythm of Life," which provides a structure of specific daily/weekly actions—such as prayer, sharing faith, and rest—to help individuals grow in their daily lives and become more like Christ.
